Many of North America's spectacular wildlife can be seen in this country. Keep your eye open for grizzly, wolf, elk, coyote, and deer.


Trails

Camping

Campgrounds on the byway are open through the summer and range in elevations from 6,500 to 8,300 feet. Be prepared for camping in bear country along the byway.




