### Popo Agie Wilderness Regulations

1. Camping within 200 feet of lakes, streams and trails is prohibited.
2. Shortcutting trails and switchbacks is prohibited.
3. Recreation livestock must stay on Forest Service system trails except where this practice is unsafe.
4. Cutting or otherwise damaging green trees is prohibited.
5. All camp structures must be dismantled ie: fire rings, hitching racks, tent frames, picket pins (metal pins are recommended).
6. No more than 30 pack and saddle stock (combined) are allowed.
7. Certified weed-free feed is required to help prevent the spread of noxious weeds. Contact Fremont County Weed & Pest at (307) 332-1052 for sources of certified weed-free hay.
8. Camping or otherwise occupying a single location for a period exceeding 16 days is prohibited.
9. Guides must hold a valid Special Use Permit.

**I understand & agree to abide by the above regulations in order to minimize the impact of my party and keep the forest pristine for future use (39 CFR 261.1k).**
