To earn your title and cool Eagle Explorer patch, simply complete the Eagle Explorer Booklet, attend two of the several programs offered weekly by Eagle Explorer partners, and return the completed booklet to any program location during regular business hours. The Eagle Explorers Junior Naturalist Program is a joint venture of the USFS White River National Forest - Holy Cross District, the Gore Range Natural Science School, the Vail Recreation District, the Betty Ford Alpine Gardens, and the Colorado Ski Museum.

The Vail Nature Center. Open Daily, 9 am-5 pm. Adjacent Ford Park and Gore Creek Trail in Vail.

The Betty Ford Alpine Gardens, Schoolhouse Gift Shop. Open Daily, 10 am-4 pm. Adjacent Ford Park in Vail

Colorado Ski Museum. Open T-Su, 10 am-5 pm. Located within the Vail Transportation Center.
