



## Accessible Fishing Opportunities

**Copper (Curtain) Ponds**- located on Ten Mile Creek Between Frisco and Copper Mountain. Exit off of Interstate 70 (I70) at Copper Mountain. Easy Access

**Green Mountain Reservoir**- Located north of Silverthorne and Dillon on Highway 9. Dispersed fishing sites around the reservoir with a moderate to difficult challenge level.

**Dickey Fishing access**- Out of Frisco going towards Breckenridge on Highway 9. Moderate to difficult challenge level.

**Officers Gulch**- Located between Copper Mountain and Frisco. Take Officers Gulch exit off of I70. Moderate to difficult challenge level.

**Black Lake**- Located off of I70 near the Vail Pass Rest Area. Moderate challenge level.

**Camp Hale**- Located between Leadville and Minturn on Highway 24, near Tennessee Pass. Moderate to difficult challenge level.

**Horn Silver Campground**- Located on Highway 24, south of Minturn. Difficult challenge level.

**Yeoman Park**- From Eagle going south, take County road 307 and onto Forest Service (FS) road 400. Turn onto FS road 415 (East Brush Creek) and 416 consecutively. Fishing access is a moderate challenge level.

**Deep Lake**- Take the Dotsero exit off of I70. About two miles north turn left on the Coffee Pot Road FS 600. Deep Lake is about 18 miles up the road. Moderate Challenge Level.

**Rocky Fork**- From Basalt take the Frying Pan River Road-County Road 104. Rocky fork is at the base of Ruedi Reservoir a out 12 miles from Basalt. The challenge level is moderate.

**Meadow Lake**- From I70 take the New Castle exit. Turn right on 7th street (County Road 226, Elk Creek). Turn right on county road 245 that becomes FS 245 on West Elk Creek. About 18 miles turn right on FS road 801 and another right on FS road 823. Moderate to difficult challenge level.
