FIRE PREVENTION PROGRAM

SPRING AGRICULTURAL BURNS

WHEN BURNING FIELDS AND ACEQUIAS, PLEASE REMEMBER:

NEVER LEAVE A BURNING FIELD UNATTENDED.

CHECK WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR WIND AND UNUSUALLY WARM TEMPERATURES.

WINTER MOISTURE MEANS INCREASED “FINE FUELS” GRASSES AND WEEDS.

CREATE A FIRE LINE AROUND THE FIELD TO BE BURNED.

STAY ON THE BURN SITE UNTIL THE FIRE IS NO LONGER A THREAT.

KEEP A WATER SUPPLY ON SITE TO HELP STOP SPREAD OF AN ESCAPED BURN.

BE AWARE OF OUTBUILDINGS OR HOUSES IN THE AREA.

HAVE THE PROPER EQUIPMENT AND ENOUGH HELP.

BE PREPARED FOR THE WORST CASE SCENARIO.

SECURE PROPER BURN PERMITS.
