PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area and roads as described in this Order and the attached map within the Mt. Taylor Ranger District, Cibola National Forest, between December 15, 2008 and March 31, 2009, and between December 15, 2009 and March 31, 2010.

1. Possessing or using a vehicle off forest development roads. 36 CFR 261.56
2. Using any motorized vehicle on the forest development roads or segments listed below as closed. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of land in the area only for the purposes of ingress and egress and use of fee or leasehold interest.
4. Residents in the area only for purposes of ingress and egress and use of fee or leasehold interest.
5. Persons using motor vehicles within 30 feet on each side of Forest Roads 400, 191, 418, and 50.

CLOSED ROADS:

1. Forest Road 166 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
2. Forest Road 164 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
3. Forest Road 503 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
4. Forest Road 496 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
5. Forest Road 162 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
6. Forest Road 151 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.

7. Forest Road 402 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
8. Forest Road 481 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
9. Forest Road 152 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
10. Forest Road 547 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.
11. Forest Road 546 and all associated spur roads inside the defined area as shown on the attached map.


PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect resources and to provide for public health and safety because of the effect of winter weather on the road surfaces.

IMPLEMENTATION


1. This Order is effective December 15, 2008 through March 31, 2009 and December 15, 2009 through March 31, 2010, unless otherwise rescinded.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
