**SPECIAL CLOSURES  
NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the area and on the roads as described in this order within the Mt. Taylor Ranger District, Cibola National Forest, in the State of New Mexico, from 8:00 p.m. on March 24, 2009 through 9:00 a.m. on March 25, 2009. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

- (1) Going into or being upon the prohibited area, which is closed for public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
- (2) Being on the roads, which are closed for public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.54(e)

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Owners or lessees of private land to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**RESTRICTED AREA:**

It is prohibited to go into or be upon the following area and roads for the protection of public health or safety within the Mt. Taylor Ranger District, Cibola National Forest and as shown on the attached map during the launch and pre-launch period.

The following sections and portions of sections as bounded by the Restricted Area:

Township 13N., Range 17W., Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15; Township 13N., Range 16W., Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8; Township 14N., Range 16W., Sections 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34; Township 14N., Range 15W., Sections 6, 7.

The following roads:

Forest Development Roads Numbers 151, 152, 162, 191, 481, 547.


**PURPOSE:**

To protect the public before and during the launch and pre-launch periods of a planned missile launch..

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect at 8:00 p.m. March 24, 2009 and shall remain in effect through 9:00 a.m. on March 25, 2009, unless otherwise rescinded.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
