SPECIAL CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited on the area as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area"), all within the Mt. Taylor Ranger District, Cibola National Forest, Cibola County, New Mexico.

1. Going into or being upon the restricted area, which is closed for public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53(e)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

RESTRICTED AREA:

1. Six mining claims know as the Mirabal Mine located within Township 11N., Range 12W., Sections 5,6,7, and 8 as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

To protect the public and their health due to the mines in this area.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect March 31, 2009, and shall remain in effect until March 31, 2011 or until rescinded.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
