Coconino County Public Works Department Extends Hours & Offers Free Forest Materials Removal At Willard Springs Transfer Station

Flagstaff, Az. – In an effort to help the communities of Munds Park/Pinewood, Kachina Village, Mountaineer and surrounding areas remove forest materials from their properties, the Coconino County Public Works Department is offering free forest materials drop-off service and extended hours for a limited time. This service does not include regular trash service; citizens will be charged regular rates for trash.

The extended hours of operation begin on Thursday, June 22 and will continue through Monday, June 26, from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. each day (including Saturday and Sunday). Attendants will be available at the station.

Due to the current drought and forest fire conditions, citizens are encouraged to clean up their properties and create defensible space around their homes.
