Dear Interested Participant,

I have decided to re-authorize grazing on the Angell Allotment for up to 425 cattle (cow/calf) from May 15 through October 31 (3,135 AUM). The authorization will be through a term grazing permit and will continue current livestock numbers and grazing management, including a 35 percent utilization guideline, adaptive management and monitoring. The area affected by the proposal includes 51,696 acres of land approximately 3 miles east of Flagstaff, Arizona on the Peaks Ranger District. Enclosed is a copy of the Angell Allotment Decision Memo. This project may be implemented immediately.

This decision is not subject to administrative appeal under 36 CFR 215.

The grazing permittee has the right to appeal under 36 CFR 251. A Notice of Appeal must be consistent with 36 CFR 251.90 and filed simultaneously with Nora Rasure, Appeal Reviewing Officer and Gene Waldrip, Deciding Officer within 45 days of the date of this decision.
