

Environmental Assessment Errata Sheet

The Errata Sheet contains revisions or corrections for minor mistakes found in the draft environmental assessment (EA). When placed with the draft EA, the Errata Sheet serves as the final EA.

1. Page 5, last sentence should read:

“The proposed utilization guideline would allow up to 35 percent use by cattle and/or wildlife during the cattle grazing season of *June* through October.”

2. Page 33, Table 4, third line item should read:

Stock tank within seasonal/semipermanent wetlands	8	No maintenance
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3. The following pages were mistakenly assembled or copied out of sequence:

- After page 40, pages 44, 43, 42, and 41 are in the wrong order and should be reversed.
- Page 59 comes after page 46 and should be moved to after page 58.

4. Page 59, sixth paragraph, first sentence should read:

“Babbitt spring *will* be fenced to exclude cattle.”

5. Page 69, last paragraph lists inaccurate acreages. It should read as follows:

Approximately **29,956** acres have satisfactory rangeland management status and a mid to high-similarity to the desired natural community with static to upward trends. Cattle currently graze a large portion of these satisfactory acres. Approximately **1,652** acres have unsatisfactory rangeland management status and a low-similarity to the desired natural community with primarily static but some downward trends. Unsatisfactory rangeland management status acres include unsatisfactory and impaired soils in dense juniper stands, grassland basins, swales, valley plains, and elevated grassland plains. Approximately **807** acres are affected by cattle and approximately **845** acres are affected by juniper.

6. Page 43 fifth paragraph has some ?????? that will be removed

7. Page 28 first bulleted paragraph should read:

“A five pasture deferred-rotation grazing system meets this practice.”
