

ORDER

Threatened/Endangered Species
Lower Lake Mary Seasonal Bald Eagle Closure

COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
Mormon Lake Ranger District

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order and Exhibit A* within the Coconino National Forest from January 1 until August 31, annually.

- (1) Go into or be upon the area, **36 CFR 261.53(a)**.
- (2) Possess or use any type of motorized vehicle off National Forest System roads, **36 CFR 261.56**.
- (3) Using a vehicle on the Forest development road segments shown in Exhibit A, **36 CFR 261.54(e)**.

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (3) Volunteers of the U.S. Forest Service specifically assigned to observe the species in the closed area.
- (4) Persons floating in water-borne craft upon waters of Lower Lake Mary, except that such persons may not land, beach, or otherwise delay passage through the closure area.

***This order affects portions of the Coconino National Forest, Mormon Lake Ranger District located in or near: Lower Lake Mary Township 20 North, Range 8 East, Section 20. See Attached Exhibit A.**

Done at Flagstaff, Arizona this 25th day of May, 2005. This order becomes effective on 26th, 2005, at 8:00 a.m. and will remain in effect until rescinded.
