

ORDER

**Public Health and Safety
Flume Trail and Area Closure**

**COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
Red Rock Ranger District**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order and Exhibit A* within the Coconino National Forest.

- (1) Go into or be upon the area, **36 CFR 261.53(a)**.
- (2) Being on a trail, **36 CFR 261.55(a)**.

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (3) Members of the Arizona Public Service crew and their contractors involved in the deconstruction.


***This order affects portions of the Red Rock District Coconino National Forest, in or near: the Irving Power Plant and the Flume Trail in Township 12 North, Range 7 East, Sections 14, 15, 21, 22, and 28. See Attached Exhibit A.**

Done at Flagstaff, Arizona this 14th day of June, 2005. This order becomes effective on June 15, 2005, at 8:00 a.m. and will remain in effect until rescinded.
