RULES and REGULATIONS

1. This application must be postmarked on or after September 8, 2008.
2. This application is good for one (1) cord of fuelwood per household.
3. Your permit must be in your possession while cutting and transporting the wood. Before leaving the cutting area, fill out the permit with the date, time, and amount cut. Failure to fill out your permit with the required information may result in a citation being issued to you.
4. The conditions of the permit do not relieve you of compliance with other regulations governing public lands.
5. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations will result in revocation of the permit.
6. All sales are final--no refunds, no extensions, no exceptions.

FUELWOOD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS--GENERAL INFORMATION NOGALES RANGER DISTRICT

Please read the application carefully, and fill it out completely, correctly, and legibly.

The 2008 cutting season on the Nogales Ranger District will be from Wednesday, October 1, 2008 through Friday, October 31, 2008.

If your application is received in our office at least a week prior to October 1, 2008, your permit will be mailed on Monday, September 22. Beginning on Monday, September 22, permits will be mailed the day following receipt of the application. After October 1, 2008, you may complete an application and receive your permit across the counter at the Nogales Ranger District office. A permit must be in your possession at all times while cutting and transporting the wood. If someone else will be cutting and transporting the wood for you, we require the name, vehicle information, and telephone number of that person. Each permit is good for one cord of fuelwood; one cord equals 128 cubic feet, or a stack measuring 4' x 4' x 8'.

A map showing the location of the cutting area will accompany each permit issued. Dead and down wood may be cut district wide (with some exceptions).

There are 150 permits to be issued for dead and down wood, district-wide. No green wood permits will be issued this year.

Your permit may be delayed if:

- We receive duplicate applications.
- We receive more than one application per household.
- Your check or money order is not enclosed with your application.
- You do not enclose a stamped-self addressed legal size envelope with your application.
- You fail to sign your application.
- It is postmarked before September 8, 2008.

If your application should be disqualified for any of the reasons given above, we will call you to make arrangements to correct the problem.
