2004 FALL FUELWOOD APPLICATIONS

SIERRA VISTA (October 22, 2004) – The Sierra Vista Ranger District now has Fuelwood Applications available for this year's cutting season. A limited number of half-cord permits for oak and juniper will be sold; for \$25.00 each on a first-come, first-service basis. There will be a limit of one permit per household, per year.

The 2004 Cutting Season will begin on Saturday, October 30th, and end on Sunday, November 14, 2004. The fuelwood area is West of Ft. Huachuca, off of State Route 83. Road conditions in the cutting area are not suitable for sedans or low clearance vehicles. For more information, please call (520) 378-0311.

To apply for a permit, pick up an application form at the Forest Service Office at 5990 South Highway 92; between Ramsey and Carr Canyons. Office hours are from 8 A.M. to 4 P.M., Monday through Friday.

Completed applications can be mailed or dropped off at the office, permits will be mailed to successful applicants.
