## **CARR CANYON ROAD TEMPORARILY CLOSED**

### **Road will Reopen when Conditions Improve**

SIERRA VISTA, AZ (December 3, 2009) – The Sierra Vista Ranger District of the Coronado National Forest announces the closure of Forest Service Road 368, also known as Carr Canyon Road, effectively immediately. The road has been closed due to icy and unsafe conditions resulting from a winter storm that moved through the area last weekend.

“We want to ensure that our forest visitors have safe experiences on our roads,” said Annette Chavez, Sierra Vista District Ranger.

Entry into the restricted area can result in a fine of up to \$5,000 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months. The road is closed from Lower Carr Picnic site and campground to Ramsey Vista Campground. It will remain closed until road conditions improve.
