

Other Conditions Applying to the 2009
Free Use Firewood Permit
Williams Ranger District, Kaibab National Forest

This permit is for the removal of **dead and down wood only** from within the permit areas shown on the attached map. Cutting areas are also signed on the ground and have orange or yellow painted trees marking the boundaries of the area. All of these areas were cut to thin the forest to improve forest health. The wood that is available is from these thinnings. Areas primarily have ponderosa pine, however, occasional pinyon pine, and/or juniper may have been cut. Only the ponderosa pine that is down on the ground may be taken with this permit. Other conditions that apply to this permit:

1. This permit is not transferable. You must be present when the wood is being cut unless you have authorized someone to cut your wood for you. This authorization must be in writing on the permit and the Forest Service must be informed.
2. To prevent soil and vegetation damage, do not drive off existing roads when soils are wet and when damage may occur.
3. Your power saw must be equipped with a .023 stainless steel spark arrestor screen.
4. **The removal record on your permit must be filled out prior to transporting the wood from the location where it was cut.**
5. Read the conditions of your permit carefully. If you have questions, please call any Forest Service office for assistance prior to gathering firewood.
6. Do not scatter piles to cut firewood.
7. Follow all rules on road use and off road travel.
8. Wood gathered under this permit may **NOT** be sold.
