




# BENHAM TRAIL #38

Williams Ranger District



## Trailhead Locations:

In Williams, turn south on Fourth Street (CR 73) and go about 3.5 miles to FR 140 and turn right (west); proceed about 0.3 mile to the trailhead. Trailhead at 7265 feet. A wheelchair accessible vault toilet, horsetrailer parking, and corral are available at the trailhead, off CR 73.



## Trail Information:

**Length:** 4.5 miles one way

**Rating:** Moderate

**Use:** Moderate

**Hiking Time:** About 5 to 6 hours round trip.

**Use Restrictions:** No motorized vehicles.

**Additional Comments:** This is a short day hike, with moderately difficult slopes going up the mountain, and easy down-grades coming back to the trailhead. If arrangements have been made for some one to meet the hikers at the top of Bill Williams Mountain, the trail ends there at 9256' (2821M). By leaving a vehicle at the Bill Williams Mountain trailhead and also at the start of Benham Trail, the day-hikers can go up one trail and down the other for a total hike of about 8.5 miles. It is also possible to connect with the Bixler Saddle Trail #72 to make a longer hike.
