




DAVENPORT HILL TRAIL #63

Williams Ranger District



Trailhead Locations:

The Davenport Hill Trail begins at the east end of the Ponderosa Trail. In Williams, turn south on Fourth Street (CR73) and go about 4 miles to FR 140. Turn east (left) onto FR 140 and follow about 3 miles to FR 132; turn north (left) onto FR 132 and go to the campground (about one mile). From the boat ramp parking area, walk the Ponderosa Trail to the east end of the loop.



Trail Information:

Length: 2.5 miles one way

Rating: Moderate

Use: Light

Hiking Time: About 2.0 hours round trip.

Use Restrictions: No motorized vehicles. Trail designed for day hikers, not recommended for horses.

Additional Comments: The trail follows Dogtown Wash about 0.3 mile and then climbs to a flat, where it follows an old logging road before turning north toward Davenport Hill. The trail ascends the hill at a gradual 8% grade to the top. Follow the same trail back to the start.
