




# DOGTOWN LAKE TRAIL #744

Williams Ranger District



## Trailhead Locations:

Trailhead at 7100 feet. Trail starts just west of the picnic area at Dogtown Lake. From Williams, take Fourth Street (CR73) south about 4 miles to the junction with Forest Road 140. Turn east (left) and go about 3 miles to FR 132; turn north (left) onto FR 132 and continue about one mile to the Dogtown Recreation Area.



## Trail Information:

**Length:** 1.8 miles one way

**Rating:** Easy. Trail is fairly flat.

**Use:** Moderate

**Hiking Time:** About .5 hours round trip.

**Use Restrictions:** No motorized vehicles. Horses are not permitted in Dogtown Campground.

**Additional Comments:** This trail provides visitors a pleasant route for a stroll around the lake. Another purpose for the trail is to prevent trampling damage to the immediate lake shore. The trail is maintained by the Williams Rotary Club.
