

ORDER
AREA CLOSURE
SMOKEY BEAR RANGER DISTRICT
LINCOLN NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to special closures **36 CFR 261.53(e) Public health or safety**, the following areas are closed to public use in this Order within the Lincoln National Forest on the Smokey Bear Ranger District.

National Forest lands along Ski Run Road (State Highway 532) starting at Mile Marker 2, including Oak Grove Campground and Forest Road 127A

Forest Road 107 at west end of City of Alamogordo Lands which border USFS lands and ending at Big Bear Canyon and south of Bonito Creek. Large meadow area commonly used for dispersed camping.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.53(e), the following persons are exempted from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act of omission
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Persons engaged in a business delivering goods, packages or services to private property or contractors performing services for the government.
- (4) At Forest Road 127A, persons owning cabins within Eagle Creek Summer Homes. Owners must obtain permit at Smokey Bear Ranger Station.

Description of Area of Prohibitions

Large meadow area east of Big Bear Canyon on south side of Bonito Creek. Areas described include Forest Service roads, trails and campgrounds past Mile Marker 2 on Ski Run Road (State Highway 532).

This Order becomes effective at **08:00 A.M.** on **Friday, August 8, 2008**, and will remain in effect until further notice.
