Legal Notice of Proposed Action
Opportunity to Comment
Two Goats Project

The Sacramento Ranger District, Lincoln National Forest is requesting your comments on the proposed Two Goats Project. The project would treat vegetation to reduce current high fuel hazards and to improve wildlife habitat and timber stands on approximately 5,350 acres. The project is located in Otero County and the legal description is Township 16 South, Range 11 East, Sections 4,5,8,9,16,17,20,21,22, 27,28,29,32,33 and 34; and Township 17 South, Range 11 East, Sections 3, 4 and 5. The north end of the project area is adjacent to private land in the High Rolls Community between West Side Road and Karr Canyon and proceeds south to the Alamo Peak Trail. This project is categorically excluded from documentation in an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement. The formal notice and comment period ends 30 days following the date of publication of this legal notice in the Alamogordo Daily News, Alamogordo, New Mexico. This publication date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to submit comments on the proposed action. Those wishing to comment on this proposal should not rely upon dates or timeframes provided by any other source. Only those who provide comment or otherwise express interest in the proposed action during the comment period will be eligible as appellants. The names and addresses of those who comment will become part of the public record. Comments must meet the requirements of 36 CFR 215.6.
