Trail head #383 is across the road.

**GOLDWATER LAKE TRAIL #396 TO SPRING AND RETURN**  
White Spar Road to White Spar Campground entrance. Park in the lot.

**WATER TOWER LOOP #315—R. #317—L.316**  
Thumb Butte Parking area.  
Trailhead near host's trailer.

**THUMB BUTTE LOOP #33**  
Thumb Butte Parking area.  
Cross road to trailhead.

**WEST BUTTE LOOP #326-#367—R. #332 (ACROSS ROAD)—#318—R.#316**  
Thumb Butte Parking area  
Cross road. Look to right for trailhead

**MINT WASH LOOP L. #345—R. #352—R.#348—R.#351—#345**  
Granite Basin Recreation boat ramp area  
Downstream to trailhead.

**BALANCED ROCK LOOP #349—R. #351**  
Granite Basin Cayuse Parking Area

**OAK & WILLOW TRAIL #003 TO TOP OF MESA**  
Juniper Mesa Wilderness  
Williamson Valley Road to FS Road 125 to 03/100 trailhead.

**NORTH MINGUS MOUNTAIN TRAIL #105 TO JUNCTION #105A**  
89A to FS Road #104. Veer left at campground to trailhead.

**WOODCHUTE TRAIL #102 TO SUMMIT AND RETURN**  
89A to Potato Patch Campground  
Walk a short way on gravel road to trailhead or drive FS Road 106 .7 miles to trailhead.

## HIKING SPREE 2008

Highlands Center for Natural History  
Prescott National Forest

The Highlands Center for Natural History, in partnership with Prescott National Forest, is launching the first "Take a Hike" Hiking Spree.

Participants have eight weeks to complete at least eight of the 12 hikes. Hikes must be completed Sept. 27 through Nov. 15. Once a hike is completed, check it off by entering the date on the form.

Hikers earn a wooden hiking stick and a specially designed metal shield that will be mounted to the stick. The shield will be stamped with a design that reflects the beauty of our local ecosystem and the words "Take A Hike Hiking Spree 2008." In subsequent years, veteran participants will earn a new shield to be added to their hiking sticks.

To claim your hiking reward, completed forms must be turned into the Highlands Center. The cost for the stick and shield will be \$10 for adults; \$5 for children under 17 years of age.
