



**UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
SANTA FE NATIONAL FOREST PACHECO FIRE BURN AREA  
STAGE III FIRE RESTRICTIONS**

**The Pacheco Fire burn area on the Santa Fe National Forest will remain in Stage III Fire Restrictions as follows:**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands on the Santa Fe National Forest within the Pacheco Fire Burn area, the "restricted area" in Santa Fe County within the state of New Mexico. The "restricted area" is as described in this Order and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

1. Going into or being upon the Pacheco Fire Burn restricted Area. 36 CFR 261.52 (e)

**RESTRICTED AREA**

All Forest System Lands –  
North of Train 163 – Rio en Medio Trail to Aspen Basin  
North of Trail 254 – Windsor Trail from Ski Basin to Trail 101  
West of Trail 101 to La Vega and west of La Vega  
West of Trail 251 to Santa Fe Baldy Ridge  
West of the Santa Fe Baldy Ridge to Trail 243  
South of Trail 243 to Trail 158 – Rio Frijoles Trail  
South of Trail 154 – Rio Frijoles Trail  
East of Forest Boundary from Trail 154 to Trail 163

## **EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempted from this order:


1. Persons with a Forest Service permit or letter specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Residents in the area accessing private property via a restricted Forest Service road.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to provide for the public's health and safety and to protect National Forest system lands, resources and facilities during the current period of fire rehabilitation activities.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order becomes effective at 12:01 a.m., Saturday, July 30, 2011, and will remain in force until rescinded or until July 30, 2012, whichever occurs first.
2. Any violation of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both. Title 16 USC 551, and Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
3. This order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
