## Forest plans Santa Fe Watershed Prescribed Burn open house

**(SANTA FE, NM)**— The Santa Fe National Forest Espanola Ranger District will be having an open house Tuesday, September 20, to provide information and gather public comments on the proposed prescribed burn project in the Santa Fe Watershed.

The open house will be conducted in the Community Room located on the second floor of the downtown public library, located at 145 Washington Avenue, Santa Fe, N.M. 87501 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

The Espanola Ranger District is soliciting comments from the public about the proposed action, and possible alternatives and issues that should be considered. Comments should be within the scope of the proposal and include supporting reasons for the deciding official's consideration. The area of the proposed fuel reduction is approximately four miles east of Santa Fe, upstream from the McClure Reservoir.

If unable to attend the public meeting, comments should be received by October 3, 2011 in person Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays, at the Espanola District Ranger Station, 1710 N. Riverside Drive, Espanola, N.M., or via mail to:
