

**ORDER 12-191-2R**

**RODEO-CHEDISKI BURN AREA**  
**SPECIAL AREA CLOSURE**  
**TONTO NATIONAL FOREST**

**Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(a) and (b)**, the following restriction is established on National Forest System Lands within the Tonto National Forest, (as outlined on the attached map) within portions of the following: T. 10 N., R 15 E.; T. 10 ½ N., R. 15 E.; T. 11 N., R. 15 E., (Canyon Creek Area).

**It is prohibited to go into or be upon any of the above described lands which are closed for the protection of public health and safety, including National Forest System Roads #33, #34, and #188, plus Trail #551 therein. 36 CFR §261.53(e)**

This restriction is in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36 CFR 261 and any other Forest Order pertaining to the described lands.

**Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a written authorization specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State local officer, or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners and lessees of private land within the area, so long as they are ingressing to or egressing from said land.
4. Persons taking game in accordance with Arizona hunting laws (ARS Title 17). **(No camping is permitted and hunters must have in their possession a valid big game tag for Unit 23)**

This Forest Order supersedes Forest Order 12-191-R, dated September 26, 2002, which is hereby terminated.
