* Allowable use in the wilderness is 40%.

The dates above are guidelines. 1,400 ewe/lambs are scheduled to graze during the 2006 season. Sheep are scheduled to graze the North Oweep Creek Upper unit first. Then graze the South Oweep Creek Lower unit for approximately one week. The band will then graze the Lower Oweep Creek, South Lower Highline, and Lambert Meadow units respectively. The band will conclude by grazing the North Upper Highline unit before leaving the allotment.

Grazing fees will be \$.27 per animal unit month this year. Fees must be paid through Lockbox collection procedures before livestock will be authorized to enter the National Forest.

Allotment Meeting Notes

A meeting was held March 26, 2007 at the Mountain View District Office. Joe Broadbent, Vance Broadbent, and Allen Huber were present. The following items were discussed:

1. Joe will graze with 1,400 ewe/lambs.
2. Livestock will start trailing on July 11th and will leave the National Forest on September 6th.
3. Allen reminded Joe and Vance to keep camps clean, place salt far away from water and trails, and follow wilderness rules and regulations.
