Thank you for your participation in the planning of the Lower Cottonwood Creek Vegetation Treatment Project located on the Greys River Ranger District. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the final decision has been made. The enclosed Decision Memo describes the actions that will be undertaken during the implementation of this project. Pursuant to orders issued on July 2 and September 16, 2005 by the U. S. District Court for the Eastern District of California in Case No. CIV F-03-6386JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is subject to appeal under 36 CFR 215. Only those individuals and organizations who submitted comments during the formal 30-day comment period will be accepted as appellants. Appeals must meet the content requirements of 36 CFR 215.14. Appeals must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Deciding Officer within 45 days of the publication of the legal notice in *The Casper Star Tribune*. The Appeal Deciding Officer is Kniffy Hamilton, Forest Supervisor. Appeals must be sent to: Appeal Deciding Officer, Bridger-Teton National Forest, P.O. Box 1888, 340 N. Emailed appeals must be submitted in rich text (.rtf) or Word (.doc) form. Documents in other formats (.tif, .jpg, .pdf, etc.) should be printed and mailed. Appeals may also be hand delivered to the above address during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
