Revised News Release: Soda Springs Ranger District

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

SODA SPRINGS, ID: The Brockman Road (Forest Road 077) in Bonneville County, Idaho will be closed September 7th, 8th, and 9th, 2004 for a culvert replacement project. Dates of the project could change somewhat based on how weather conditions affect worker access.

The location of the closure is at the road's crossing of an unnamed tributary of Clear Creek, approximately 4 miles north of the junction of Brockman Road and the McCoy Creek Road (Forest Road 087). This location is about 5 miles northeast of Herman, Idaho; 14 miles north of Wayan, Idaho; and 18 miles west of Alpine, Wyoming.

The purpose of the project is to install a larger culvert that will be less prone to blockage by beavers, less likely to threaten the road with wash-out, and provide better fish passage. Forest Officials appreciate the public's patience as our crews complete this important project.
