



Transportation - Motor Vehicle Use

Public Routes are those roads and trails under some type of public jurisdiction (State, County, other Federal Agency, etc.) needed to display a continuous route across Forest Service Lands on the Motor Vehicle Use Map or to display access to Forest Service routes.

Open Areas are those areas identified as open to cross-country travel. There are two areas—just west of Richfield on the Fillmore Ranger District and the Velvet Ridges area at the south end of the Loa subsection of the Fremont River Ranger District.
