NOTICE OF DECISION  
UTAH NORTHRN GOSHAWK PROJECT

On March 14, 2000, Regional Forester Jack A. Blackwell made a decision to implement Alternative F as the management direction to maintain and restore habitat for the northern goshawk on the National Forests in Utah. The decision amends the goals, objectives, standards, guidelines and monitoring requirements established in the current land and resource management plans (forest plans) for the Ashley, Dixie, Fishlake, Manti-LaSal, Uinta, and Wasatch-Cache National Forests. The amendments will be in effect until the forest plans are revised.

This decision is subject to administrative appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 217.3. A written appeal must be postmarked or received in duplicate by the Appeal Reviewing Officer within 45 days of the publication of this legal notice. Appeals must meet the content requirements of 36 CFR 217.9, with two copies mailed to: Chief, USDA Forest Service; ATTN: Appeals Office, EMC, 3-Central; PO Box 96090, Washington, DC 20090-6090.
