## **Clear Creek Fuels Reduction and Ecosystem Enhancement Project Open House**

**Carson City, Nevada...**The Carson Ranger District, is hosting a public open house meeting to provide the public with information related to the Clear Creek Fuels Reduction and Ecosystem Project. The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, July 23, 2008 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Carson City Community Center, Sierra Room, 851 E. William Street, Carson City, Nevada.

The public is invited to come learn more about the project and have a chance to ask staff from the planning team questions they may have. Anyone interested in hazardous fuels reduction is encouraged to attend.

The purpose of this project is to:

- Reduce fuel loading and ladder fuels on National Forest System lands adjacent to the wildland urban interface West of Carson City.
- Reduce dense vegetation in order to increase health and growth rates in the forested ecosystem.
- Enhance and expand existing aspen stands.
- Improve the quantity and quality of mule deer forage and deer winter range.
- Help firefighters control and/or suppress potential wildland fires.
