### **Forest Service Requests Comments on Grant Application to California Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Division**

**Sparks, Nevada...**The Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest is submitting a grant application to the California State Parks Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Division for the 2008-2009 grants and cooperative agreements program. Portions of the Carson and Bridgeport Ranger Districts are located in the Eastern Sierra in California.

The application includes a law enforcement grant for summer and winter patrols, development grant to expand the Hope Valley Sno-park and ground operations' grant, which includes trail maintenance and signing. Friends of Hope Valley, a nonprofit organization, are applying for a safety and education grant in cooperation with the Forest.

Humboldt-Toiyabe grant applications will be available for public review and comment through the on-line grants and agreements (OLGA) website starting March 3 through April 6, 2009.
