Forest Service Seeking Public Comments to Reissue Special Use Permit for Snowmobile Tours

Carson City, Nevada...The Carson Ranger District is seeking comments on a proposal to reissue a special use permit for guided snowmobile tours and trail grooming in Alpine County, California. The project area is located off Highway 89 and Blue Lakes Road in the area of Charity Valley, Faith Valley, and Blue Lakes Road. The permit covers tours that occur on the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest.

The Forest Service is hosting two public meetings to discuss this project:

- Tuesday February 10, 2009, at Turtle Rock Park Community Center at 17300 State Route 89, Markleeville, California, from 6:00-8:00 p.m.; and,
