Road Work to Begin June 9 on Murphy Complex Fire

Wells, Nevada...Beginning on June 9, 2008, the Forest Service will resume post-Murphy Complex Fire road repairs. All road work will be completed by June 20, 2008.

Work will involve:

- Installing culverts along the entire road segment for Meadow Creek Road from Hicks Mountain turn-off to the Bruneau River, and then east toward Diamond-A Ranch to a point just south of Bearpaw Mountain.
- Realigning roads at Trail Gulch (near Bearpaw Mountain, approximately three miles east-southeast of Rowland).
- Completing additional drainage work on the Bruneau Road at Rattlesnake Gulch, three miles southeast of the confluence of Meadow Creek and the Bruneau River.

During road work on the Meadow Creek road segment, delays can be expected for up to several hours during culvert replacements. During Rattlesnake Gulch, the Bruneau Road work, that segment will be closed for up to 10 hours a day. During realignment work at Trail Creek site, delays will be up to 6 hours long.
