

Your Comments

We invite your comments on issues, opportunities, concerns and suggestions that are related to the Proposed Action described in the Notice of Intent, published on November 26, 2008. The comment period on the Proposed Action extends to December 31, 2008, but we encourage you to get your comments to us as soon as possible.

Your comments will help us in a number of ways. Any new information you provide will help us develop a sustainable motorized transportation system that provides an array of opportunities for recreation and access, while protecting sensitive resources. Your comments will be used to help identify important issues or concerns about the proposal, which will then be used to refine the proposed action that will be analyzed in a Draft and Final Environmental Impact Statement during 2009.

It is important to note that this comment period is not a “voting” exercise. A single comment which raises an important issue will have the same weight as thousands of identical comments. Multiple identical comments provide the Forest with the same identical issue and are not given additional weight. We do not maintain a numerical count of identical comments.

Comments should be submitted in writing – e-mail is preferred. A comment form is included for your convenience and will help us collect route-specific input in a consistent way. This form is optional, and your comments are welcome in any format if the form does not meet your needs.
