These instructions supplement and are part of your Term Grazing Permit number 80110, as provided for in Part 2, Clause 8 (a) of your Term Grazing Permit. All parts of your grazing permit are incorporated by reference. Failure to comply with these instructions and all parts of your Term Grazing Permit is a violation of the term grazing permit and may result in suspension or cancellation of all or a portion of the term grazing permit.

An Actual Use Report must be submitted to your Range Management Specialist by December 31, 20XX as specified in Part 3, page xx of your permit.

Rotation Schedule: the paster rotation for each allotment is specified in the Term Grazing Permit page 13a. Time in unit can be extended or shortened depending on the availability of forage. Time in allotment is limited to 3 month period of use, not to exceed head months listed in permit page 13a in a single season.

Salting: Salt must be placed no closer than ¼ mile from water sources, designated roads, trails, or recreation sites. All other managemant practices must be consistant with page 9 of the Term Grazing Permit.

Maintenance: Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. Wildlife escape ramps must be installed in all troughs.

By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present.
