Salting: Salt must be placed no closer than ¼ mile from water sources, designated roads, trails, or recreation sites. All other management practices must be consistent with page 10 of the Term Grazing Permit.

Maintenance: Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. Wildlife escape ramps must be installed in all troughs.

New Improvements: No new Improvements for the 2008 grazing season

Other:

By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present. All markings must meet the State and/or County standards for certification as weed free.
