These are the Annual Operating Instructions for the Guerry Sheep S&G & Goat Creek CU allotment for 2008. These instructions supplement and are part of your Term Grazing Permit number 80122, as

provided for in Part 2, Clause 8 (a) of your Term Grazing Permit. All parts of your grazing permit are incorporated by reference. Failure to comply with these instructions and all parts of your Term Grazing Permit is a violation of the term grazing permit and may result in suspension or cancellation of all or a portion of the term grazing permit.

An Actual Use Report must be submitted to your Range Management Specialist by December 31, 2008 as specified in Part 3, page 11 of your permit.

Movement of Livestock: When livestock are moved to the next unit, the unit will be cleaned within 5 days of the movement date. Unless prior approval is received from Jarbidge District Office, complete livestock removal will be attained by the last date of the specified season. Specific trailing and livestock movement routes are as per attached maps.

Salting: Salt must be placed no closer than ¼ mile from water sources, designated roads, trails, or recreation sites. All other management practices must be consistent with pages 10-11 of the Term Grazing Permit.

Maintenance: Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. Wildlife escape ramps must be installed in all troughs.

New Improvements:

Other: By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present. All markings must meet the State and/or County standards for certification as weed free.
