Rotation Schedule

This allotment is in a deferred rotation grazing system.

Salting: Salt must be placed no closer than ¼ mile from water sources, designated roads, trails, or recreation sites.

Maintenance:

Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. All troughs must have wildlife escape ramps.

New Improvements:

Trough replacements may be done in conjunction with wildlife pending agreement by permittee.

Dennis Bieroth and Nancy Prall will meet during the summer to retake photo points that exist on Chicken Creek and McCall Creek.

Other:

By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present. All markings must meet the State and/or County standards for certification as weed free.
