These are the Annual Operating Instructions for the East Independence C&H, Jerritt Canyon C&H, Mill Creek C&H, Deep Creek C&H allotments for 2008. These instructions supplement and are part of your

Term Grazing Permit number 60105, as provided for in Part 2, Clause 8 (a) of your Term Grazing Permit. All parts of your grazing permit are incorporated by reference. Failure to comply with these instructions and all parts of your Term Grazing Permit is a violation of the term grazing permit and may result in suspension or cancellation of all or a portion of the term grazing permit.

An Actual Use Report must be submitted to your Range Management Specialist by December 31, 2007 as specified in Part 3, page 14 of your permit.

Discussion items:

1. Adjustments to Jerritt Canyon C&H due to Snow Canyon fire-grazed in 2008 but cattle must stay off of the burned area at all times.
2. East Independence C&H back to 2 year rest rotation system as specified in EA of 1992. The Wrights will follow the EA guidelines.
3. North Fork fence re-construction to begin this summer.
4. Burns Basin pasture is re-opened after mine reconstructed fence. Will be used this year for moving cattle out of Gance Creek if needed on a trial basis until water and use patterns are more clear.

Salting: Salt must be placed no closer than ¼ mile from water sources, designated roads, trails, or recreation sites.

Maintenance:

Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. Wildlife escape ramps must be installed in all troughs.

New Improvements:

None planned for 2008.

Other:

By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present. All markings must meet the State and/or County standards for certification as weed free.
