Improvement maintenance will be done prior to turn out. Wildlife escape ramps must be installed in all troughs.

**New Improvements:**

Discussion with Phil about thistle in Cobb Creek, Phil is willing to cooperate with us in some spraying in the summer of 2008.

**Other:**

**By USDA order 04-00-097, all non-pelletized hay, straw or mulch processed, stored, or transported on National Forest System Lands, in individual bales or containers, must be tagged or marked as weed free, or must have the original and current evidence of weed free certification documentation present. All markings must meet the State and/or County standards for certification as weed free.**
