# Northern Utah Interagency Runcards, 2008

Effective June 1 through October 31.

**Notifications will occur at any time of year.**

The Interagency Runcards are developed by a group of interagency representatives to provide instructions to the Northern Utah Interagency Fire Center for initial attack dispatching wildland fire management resources within pre-identified geographic areas (Dispatch Zones).

The runcards are used when a wildfire is reported and nothing else is known about it. **When qualified initial attack Incident Commanders have visual confirmation of a fire they may adjust the initial attack response as needed** by either canceling resources currently en-route (or about to be dispatched) or ordering resources.

## **After Hours Dispatch Procedures:**

**BLM:** After normal business hours, dispatchers will contact the BLM duty officer who will determine the level of response for BLM fires. Dispatchers are still responsible for making all notifications per the Runcard.

**STATE:** After normal business hours, dispatchers will notify the State Area FMO who will determine the level of response for state and private fires. Dispatchers are still responsible for making all notifications per the Runcard.

**USFS:** After normal business hours, dispatchers will notify the USFS duty officer who will determine the level of response for USFS fires. Dispatchers are still responsible for making all notifications per the Runcard.

## **Notes:**

- Volunteer and County Fire Departments that are not previously known to meet NWCG standards will not be counted as meeting the Runcard requirements for numbers of resources during the initial attack dispatch. (Utah County Wildland resources are NWCG qualified).
- During periods of large/multiple fire activity, when there are not enough resources to follow the Runcards, the Duty Officers from FFSL, USFS and BLM will be available to the Northern Utah Interagency Fire Center to assist in the initial attack incident prioritization process.
- The Northern Utah Interagency MAC group will convene and prioritize extended attack fires or as warranted.
- The BLM FOS have been delegated the authority to position/assign BLM IA resources as they deem appropriate.

## **Minimum and Extended Staffing Guidelines BLM Salt Lake Field Office**

*Minimum* and *extended* staffing of initial attack resources are measures taken by local fire management in order to effectively respond to reported fires under specific fire weather and fire business parameters. Staffing decisions are made by the Duty Officer based on the local Preparedness Level (PL).

***Minimum and extended staffing is contingent upon funding which may (or may not) be available to the fire management staff. Local work and rest policies supercede *minimum and extended* staffing guidelines.***

*Minimum staffing* refers to suppression resource staffing levels which should be available during normal hours (0930-1800); this may require an augmentation of regularly scheduled initial attack resources. *Minimum staffing* is based on the forecasted PL for the following day. It is calculated by NUIFC personnel by 1630 hrs and relayed to the Duty Officer.

Extended staffing is an extension of normal staffing hours which typically occurs in two-hour increments. Extended staffing is based on the actual PL calculated by NUIFC personnel by 1530 hrs and relayed to the Duty Officer. It is possible that the PL would increase before the end-of-shift due to additional fire occurrence after 1530 hrs.

### **Minimum staffing guidelines:**

- **PL 1 – 2 :** Normal staffing (regular tour-of-duty)
- **PL 3:** The East and West Zones will have a minimum of one engine available in each zone. In addition, both FOS and one watertender will be available.
- **PL 4:** The East and West Zones will have a minimum of two engines available in each zone. In addition, both FOS and one watertender will be available.
- **PL 5:** The East and West Zones will have a minimum of three engines available in each zone. In addition, both FOS and one watertender will be available.

### **Minimum staffing guidelines (Severity Funding):**

- **PL 1 - 2:** Normal staffing (regular tour-of-duty)
- **PL 3 - 5:** The East and West Zones will have a minimum of three engines available in each zone. In addition, both FOS and one watertender will be available.

### **Extended staffing guidelines (Severity Funding):**

- **PL 1 – 3:** No resource extension.
- **PL 4 – 5:** All available resources will extend.

**These guidelines may be altered by fire management at any time in order to address unique situations encountered during the planning process.**
