Travel Management Maps**

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Introduction

Summer

This packet includes the two maps that show the existing and proposed summer travel management described in FEIS Chapter 2. One map is the west side of the Forest (MAs 1 through 4), and one is the east side (MAs 3 through 13). The maps are for Alternative E, as the DEIS map packet provided the maps for Alternatives A through D.

Proposed changes (Proposals) are shown by Proposal Identification (Proposal ID) number. Each Proposal is found in one or more of the alternatives described in Chapter 2. Tables 2-2 through 2-26 in Chapter 2 in concert with the maps show how the proposals differ by alternative.

In areas where dispersed camping and parking are in designated sites only – Krassel Ranger District, Lake Creek on the McCall Ranger District, and northern Idaho ground squirrel habitat on the west side of the Forest – designated sites are symbolized with either a tent for dispersed camping or a “TH” for a trailhead.

Winter

Winter maps are in the FEIS volume at the end of Chapter 2. These color (8 1/2” x 11”) maps display the winter management proposals for winter motorized area closures and for snowmobile grooming.
