Dear Ms. Figlietti:

We received the appeal you filed. You appealed the decision by District Ranger Gary Schiff approving the Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact for the Martis Travel Management Plan Revision.

Regretfully, I must dismiss your appeal without review in accordance with 36 CFR 215.6. The record for this project indicates that you did not provide written or oral comments during the 30-day comment period that was initiated by publication of a legal notice in the paper of record, the Reno Gazette Journal on June 6, 2007. To be eligible to appeal, individuals or organizations must submit written or oral comments during the 30-day comment period (36 CFR 215.13).

No eligible appellants submitted an appeal. Therefore, the District Ranger's decision will be implemented. As a primary component of that decision, Forest System Road 462, as it exists on National Forest land, will continue to remain open to motorized vehicles on the Carson Ranger District throughout most of the year.

I appreciate your concerns regarding public access to FSR 462 from the Iceland Road, Hirschdale east to the National Forest boundary. In recognition of those concerns, the Carson Ranger District:

- Issued a corrected Decision that removed the non- National Forest portion of the Iceland road from the map and deleted wording which referenced public access on this road segment ("Bronco Creek near Hirschdale", Decision Notice, p.2, ¶ 3).
- Anticipates releasing a Motor Vehicle Use Map next year that displays forest roads open to public motorized use. The Iceland Road (outside the National Forest boundary) will not be shown on this map and thus will not be shown as open to public motorized use.
- Added your name to their mailing list for notification of future projects with the potential to influence the Hirschdale area.
- Committed to publish future legal notices in the newspaper serving the Hirschdale area, along with the Reno Gazette-Journal (Carson Ranger District "Newspaper of Record"), for projects which may interest residents of Nevada County.



- Will continue to communicate with Nevada County regarding their resolution of Iceland Road jurisdiction and maintenance issues, and other issues of mutual concern.

This constitutes the final administrative determination of the U.S. Department of Agriculture under 36 CFR 215.18(c).
