Introduction

The Richfield Interagency Fire Center (RIFC) is located in central Utah. The response area of RIFC and the Central Utah Fire Organization consists of over twelve million acres including U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, BIA Tribal, State Division of Wildlife, and Utah State lands. Seven counties are included within the jurisdiction boundaries: Juab, Millard, Sevier, Sanpete, Piute, Wayne, and Beaver. Interstate highways I-15 and I-70 transect through the area as well as major highways. The terrain includes the Great Basin Desert, the Colorado Plateau, fertile valleys, and high mountain ecosystems. Elevations range from approximately 4,000 to over 12,000 feet.

Highlights

The drought continued in southern Utah with high to extreme fire danger occurring most of the summer. The 1,000-hour fuel moistures were 10% or below. It was anticipated that the area could experience a heavy fire season and preparations were made.

The number of fires that occurred and the number of acres burned were above average. We had 307 fires for 43,925 acres. However, the largest fire of 31,727 acres was managed in a confined strategy. With that fire and acreage removed from the total, we had 306 fires for 12,198 acres.

Aviation

The Central Utah Fire organization supported one Type-3 helicopter, a Bell 206 L1-C30P, under an exclusive use contract. The helicopters duty station was the Richfield helibase located at the Richfield airport. Also, under an exclusive use contract, one air-attack/reconnaissance fixed wing aircraft, a Cessna 337T. This was also stationed at the Richfield airport. Both exclusive use contracts are administered by the BLM. In addition to the exclusive use contracted aircraft the BLM acquired two Single Engine Airtankers (SEAT) on Call When Needed (CWN) contracts. Both aircraft were M-18B Dromaders. Contract administration was handled by the BLM. Funding was possible through severity dollars. These two aircraft were positioned at Fillmore for the beginning of the season, then as conditions warranted one was moved to Nephi. This allowed for relatively quick response times from two central locations within the district. The SEATs proved to be a useful addition to the aerial firefighting resources of the district.

The helicopter flew a total of 94 missions including fire and non-fire for 311.1 hours. The helicopter also transported a total of 1,366 passengers, transported 49,405 internal and 78,478 external pounds of cargo, dropped 68,539 gallons of water, dropped 950 gallons of helitorch mix, dropped 103,100 plastic spheres, and 3,550 pounds of seed.

The air-attack airplane flew a total of 200.71 hours in support of fire and reconnaissance missions and transported a total of 112 passengers.

The two SEATS flew a total of 152.33 hours and dropped 116,500 gallons of liquid (retardant/foam/water).

SEASONAL WEATHER AND SEVERITY

The drought continued this season. From June through September the area was in very high to extreme fire danger for 26% of the season. In June there were very hot and dry conditions. The fire danger ratings were between moderate and high for **66%** of the season. Even with fire danger ratings staying in the moderate to high range, we had multiple fires that showed extreme behavior throughout the season.




Overview of Large Fires



Eight fires accounted for 98% of the total acres burned. The remaining 295 fires totaled less than 600 acres. All the large fires except for the Bulldog fire were lightning-caused. Exhaust from an ATV was suspected for starting the 31,727- acre Bulldog fire.

The Lonesome Beaver and Bulldog fires were managed in a confined status with minimum suppression to provide for the most cost-effective strategy. The fires were in primarily remote areas of the Henry Mountains by Hanksville. Access was very limited due to steep terrain. Jerry Brunner's Type 2 team was brought in to work with agency representatives to formalize the strategy for the two fires and assist with confinement tactics.



Cost Effectiveness and Cooperation

The Central Utah Fire Organization continues to promote cooperation between all agencies and cooperators. The initial attack function continues to improve with most fires kept small. The increased coordination has promoted an effective response to initial reports of wildland fires.

The total human-caused fires were kept to 20% of the total number of fires. This can be attributed to the fire prevention program and an increased awareness in local communities.



This year the Central Utah fire organization supported activities other than fire including national emergencies such as the Newcastle chicken disease in Nevada, and the space shuttle recovery in Texas. Since these activities occurred outside normal fire season, permanent fire and non-fire personnel were used as well as a national-contract crew.

Resource Ordering and Status System a.k.a. ROSS


A new resource ordering system was implemented in 2003. This web based electronic ordering system was designed to replace the old pencil and paper method. There was a steep learning curve at the beginning but by mid season most dispatchers were ROSS proficient. While the program does have a few bugs to work out and some fine tuning the general consensus was to stay with the program and not take a step backward to the old system. The following part of the report is based on data acquired from the ROSS database.

The Fire Center experienced an abnormal increase in activity early in the year. The first orders were processed in January in response to supporting APHIS with an outbreak of Newcastle Disease in Nevada. Various overhead positions were requested as well as clean up crews. Shortly afterward the agencies were requested to participate in the recovery effort of the Space Shuttle Columbia. Once again we sent out overhead as part of IMT's and also various single resource assignments. Many hours were spent putting together camp crews and search crews. It became apparent that fire was not the only mission we would be asked to support. The graphs below are designed to depict the Centers workload by week, the total number of resource requests we processed by resource type, and agency contributions to these requests. ***Note: These totals are based only on orders placed via the ROSS program they do not include initial attack resource assignments.**


WEEKLY WORKLOAD OF ROSS REQUESTS




There is a concerted effort from all participating agencies to contribute resources. Each works to support internal and external incident requests regardless of agency.



RIFC filled 296 resource requests for off unit assignment. A breakdown of resource type sent and to which geographic area it went is listed below.




Pie charts break down the off zone resource requests by the category item name of resource sent.




Aircraft chart shows requests filled by RIFC for off district assignments. While RIFC does not maintain "ownership" of National Aerial Firefighting Resources, these resources were in RIFC's operational control when the order for said resource was placed with RIFC. AIRCRAFT BY TYPE




CREWS BY TYPE




With a total of 307 fires for the fire district in 2003 821 resource requests were placed and filled to support these incidents. This number does not include orders that were placed and then cancelled or returned unable to fill. Out of the 821 requests RIFC filled 491 of these with resources that are under RIFC's operational control. The other 330 orders were placed with neighboring dispatch centers or to Eastern Great Basin Coordination Center.

The following charts display how many resource orders were placed by each agency, also, item name breakdowns for the equipment, aircraft, and crew categories.


ON ZONE FILLED REQUESTS BY RESOURCE TYPE




EQUIPMENT BY TYPE


