Introduction

The Richfield Interagency Fire Center (RIFC) is located in central Utah. The response area of RIFC and the Central Utah Fire Organization consists of over twelve million acres including U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, BIA Tribal, State Division of Wildlife, and State Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands. Eight counties are included within the jurisdiction boundaries: Juab, Millard, Sevier, Sanpete, Piute, Wayne, Garfield and Beaver. Interstate highways I-15 and I-70 transect through the area as well as major highways. The terrain includes the Great Basin Desert, the Colorado Plateau, fertile valleys, and high mountain ecosystems. Elevations range from approximately 4,000 to over 12,000 feet.

Highlights

The drought continued in southern Utah with high to extreme fire danger occurring most of the summer. More regular storm systems came through the area, keeping fires small in size and with short durations. The 1,000-hour fuel moistures were 12% or below.

The number of fires that occurred was average and the number of acres burned was below average. We had 228 fires for 8,941 acres. However, the largest fire of 4,762 acres was managed in a Wildland Fire Use strategy. With that fire and acreage removed from the total, we had 227 fires for 4,179 acres. The fire center had 115 False Alarms.

Aviation

The Central Utah Fire organization supported one Type-3 helicopter (N3895D), a Bell 206 L1-C30P, under an exclusive use contract. Helicopter 95D's duty station was the Richfield helibase located at the Richfield Airport/RIFC. Helicopter 45Y was here for a short time in June until 95D was available to fill the contract for the season. Also, under an exclusive use contract, one air-attack/reconnaissance fixed wing aircraft (N1ZJ), a Cessna 337T. This was also stationed at the Richfield Airport. Both exclusive use contracts are administered by the BLM. In addition to the exclusive use contracted aircraft, the BLM acquired two Single Engine Airtankers (SEAT) on Call When Needed (CWN) contracts. The SEAT aircrafts are M-18B Dromaders. We started out the season with T-463 and T-489. In mid-June T-463 was sent to St. George, UT to fill Color Country's Exclusive Use Contract. Funding was possible through severity dollars. T-489 was positioned at Fillmore. This allowed for relatively quick response times from a central location within the district.

The helicopter flew approximately 100 missions including fire and non-fire for 203.3 hours. The helicopter also transported a total of 843 passengers, transported 27,191 pounds of internal cargo, 86,593 pounds of external cargo, dropped 66,931 gallons of water, 6000 gallons of helitorch mix, and dropped 12,000 plastic spheres.

The air-attack airplane flew a total of 137.66 hours in support of fire and reconnaissance missions and transported a total of 97 passengers. This is the third season that an air-attack ship was part of the Run Cards.

The SEATs flew on-district a total of 30.19 hours and dropped 4,170 gallons of retardant and 18,650 gallons of foam/water. T-489 supported Color Country for 50% (34.72 hrs) of its total use. T-463 was only here a short time on severity and then was sent to fill Color Country's exclusive use contract.

SEASONAL WEATHER AND SEVERITY

The drought continued this season. From June through September the area was in very high to extreme fire danger for 35% of the season. The fire danger ratings were between Moderate and High for 54% of the season. We experienced moderate temperatures throughout the season.





Overview of Large Fires

Eight fires accounted for 94% of the total acres burned. The remaining 220 fires totaled 507 acres. Our Largest fire was a WFU at 4,762 - acres (6 Mile fire). RIFC made it through fire season 2004 without calling in any Type 1 or Type 2 incident teams.

The 6 Mile fire was managed in a Wildland Fire Use strategy. The fire was located east of Sterling, UT on the Manti LaSal National Forest in the Six Mile drainage. The fire burned 4,707 acres on the Manti LaSal and 55 acres on State Land. Kim Soper was the Fire Use Manager for a complex of WFU's. This included the Razor Back fire, Beaver Creek fire, and several others in Moab Interagency Fire Centers Dispatch zone. Two FEMO's were on scene everyday throughout the incident. On September 2nd the fire grew in size significantly and again on September 18th. The 6 Mile fire ordered 3-Type1 airtankers, 1-lead plane, 1-Type 1 crew, 1-dozer, and filled 10 overhead orders. The fire was declared controlled and out on October 23rd..

The Dog Valley Hill was managed by the local Type 3 Team. Tyler Monroe was the ICT3 (t) and Jay Beckstrand was the qualified ICT3. The fire was located west of Nephi, UT in Dog Valley. Initial Attack resources included 1-Type 3 helicopter, 1-air-attack, 1-SEAT, 5-engines, 1-watertender, and 2-Volunteer Fire Department engines. Additional resources ordered and filled were 2-Type 2IA crews, 2- dozers, 4-engines, 1-excavator, 1-watertender, and 24-overhead. During the first operational period threatened resources included power lines, a gas power station, a structure to the east, and the turkey sheds to the north. The concern was with wind gusts to 20 mph and steep, inaccessible terrain. The fire was declared controlled and out on August 5th.


The Salt Creek Fire was managed by the local Type 3 Team. Eddie Taylor was the ICT3 (t) and Glen Chappell was the qualified ICT3. Howard Allred was ICT3 for night operations. Salt Creek was located southeast of Levan, UT. It burned 449 acres on BLM and 1,034 on State/Private. The fire burned in oak bush and pinyon/juniper fuel models. In the first operational period the fire experienced extreme fire behavior. During operational periods thereafter moderate to high fire behavior was observed. The fire had an unusually large organization for the typical Type 3. A management decision was made by SCS to not bring in a Type 2 team. Salt Creek ordered 15-aircraft with 14 filled, 3-Type 1 crews, 9-Type 2IA or 2 crews, 2-camp crews, 2-dozers, 9-Type 6 engines, 1-Type 1 engine, 10-watertenders, 1-Type 3 logistics trailer, 1-mobile shower, 1-mobile caterer, 6-ATV's, and filled 50 overhead positions. A cost share agreement was done for this incident. The fire was controlled on August 30th and out on September 9th, 2004.

The Razor Back fire was managed in a Wildland Fire Use strategy. The fire was approximately 10 miles southeast of Emery, UT on the Fishlake National Forest (Old Woman Plateau). Kim Soper was the Fire Use Manager. The fire was a total of 228 acres. FEMO's were on scene throughout most of the duration of the incident. The observed fire behavior was backing downslope and then taking runs to the top. The fire also experienced spotting with runs. The Richfield District Ranger was pleased by the fires end results. The Razor Back fire was controlled and out on September 30th, 2004. The After Action Review was done on October 7th.





There was a total of 228 fires this year. Human-caused fires only accounted for 20% of all fires and 8% of total acres burned. The Utah Division of Forestry, Fire, and State Lands had the most human-caused fires with 75%.


PERCENT OF HUMAN CAUSED FIRES BY AGENCY




PERCENT OF LIGHTNING CAUSED FIRES BY AGENCY

Cost Effectiveness and Cooperation

The Central Utah Fire Organization continues to promote cooperation between all agencies and cooperators. The initial attack function continues to improve with most fires kept small. The increased coordination has promoted an effective response to initial reports of wildland fires.


The total human-caused fires were kept to 20% of the total number of fires and only 8% of the total acres. This can be attributed to the fire prevention program and an increased awareness in local communities. Our Prevention Education program has been in full force since 2001 and along with the County Wardens efforts, this program has resulted in a drop in our number of human caused starts.

Resource Ordering and Status System a.k.a. ROSS

Once again we sent out overhead as part of incident management teams and also various single resource assignments. A few of our overhead resources were able to assist FEMA in the Hurricane Frances, Ivan, and Jeanne Response and Recovery efforts. It became apparent once again that fire was not the only mission we would be asked to support. Do to our more average season we were able to send resources to support Color Country in their very busy fire season. The following graphs are designed to depict the Center's workload, the total number of resource requests we processed by resource type, and agency contributions to these requests. There is a concerted effort from participating agencies to contribute resources. Each agency works to support internal and external incident requests regardless of ownership. **Note: These totals are based only on orders placed via the ROSS program they do not include initial attack resource assignments.*


OVERHEAD ASSIGNMENTS TOTALS BY AGENCY

CREWS



SQUADS



ON-DISTRICT INCIDENTS




CAMP CREWS

The Central Utah Camp crews were sent to 9 fires, of which 1 assignment was on-district and 8 assignments were off- district.




ENGINES / WATERTENDERS


ON-DISTRICT INCIDENTS

Based on WildCAD





FIRE WARDENS


