

NOTICE OF DECISION
ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
INDIAN CREEK ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT
USDA – FOREST SERVICE
SALMON – CHALLIS NATIONAL FOREST
NORTH FORK RANGER DISTRICT
LEMHI COUNTY, IDAHO

Acting North Fork District Ranger Terry Hershey signed a Decision Notice to implement Alternative B, in the Indian Creek Road Reconstruction Project Environmental Assessment. This action will repair the Indian Creek road washout by constructing a new road prism, approximately 1160 feet in length and 14 feet in width, east of the washed out section of the Indian Creek road. The decision includes design criteria, best management practices, mitigation and monitoring requirements.

This decision is subject to administrative review (appeal) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 215. Individuals or non-federal organizations that submitted substantive comments during the comment period specified at 215.6 may appeal this decision. The Notice of Appeal must be in writing, meet the appeal content requirements at 36CFR 215.14 and be filed (regular mail, fax, email, hand delivery, or express delivery) with the Appeal Deciding Officer:

The Notice of Appeal, including attachments, must be filed with the Appeal Deciding Officer at the correct location within 45 calendar days of the publication of this legal notice in *The Recorder Herald* newspaper, the newspaper of record. Attachments received after the 45-day appeal period will not be considered. The publication date in the Recorder Herald, newspaper of record, is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Those wishing to appeal this decision should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source.

Appeals submitted electronically, including attachments, must be in an electronic format such as an email message plain text (.txt), rich text format (.rtf), or Word (.doc). In cases where no identifiable name is attached to an electronic message, a verification of identity will be required. A scanned signature is one way to provide verification. Electronic appeals should be e-mailed to: appeals-intermtn-regional-office@fs.fed.us. Fax written appeals to (208) 756-5555. Hand delivered appeals will be accepted at the Salmon-Challis National Forest Office during normal business hours (7:45 am to 4:30 pm) Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

If no appeal is filed within the 45 day time period, implementation of this decision may occur on, but not before, 5 business days from the close of the appeal filing period. If an appeal is received, implementation may not occur for 15 days following the date of the last appeal disposition.
