6/04/2007, Check to see if cattle were in the units; cattle on road corridor, none in units. *S. Jones*

6/07/2007, Cattle in units. *S. Jones*

6/13/2007, I checked Whiskey Creek today to look at greenline to determine if we should reread it. Very heavy elk use all through the greenline area. Would be good to read this one all though it will not score very high. Cattle in Willow Springs, Bell Field and Hood Gulch. Also numerous cattle on road corridor. There are cattle on private near old cabins at the mouth of Wildcat Creek. The ditch that feeds the trough in Willow Springs has several leaks that are crossing the road; also the outlet of this ditch is flooding a large section of the road due to no barrow ditch to speak of. *J. 6/25/2007, Sheldon and I were in Hood Gulch today to finish MIM reading. Cattle have been moved out of Hood Gulch (over last weekend) into Bell Field. The Chippie gate into Free-strip was open but a lot of cattle were still on the Bell Field. Time to move the cattle out of Bell Field unit; there have been cattle in there since turn out. Cattle in Salt Creek as of least last Thursday, 6/21/2007. *J. Robson*

6/27/2007, Cattle have been moved out of Bell Field. Cattle are well dispersed in the Freestrip unit. Sheldon and I read the Greenline (MIM) on Chippie Creek. Moved a salt block that was near the Chippie Creek. Talk to Carl Lufkin at Irish boy spring, they repaired the enclosure fence and installed a steel storage tank (replacing the bladders) to supply the lower troughs in Mollie Gulch. *J. Robson*

7/11/2007, Sheldon and I drove up Frank Hall and re took the G.L. photos. I than drove through the Salt Creek units; cows were at the trough above the creek. Several dozen cattle in the lower unit, gates closed. Most cattle were in the upper unit with a dozen plus the Salt Creek enclosure. The second trough on the pipeline was working good and receiving lots of use. The pond above salt was receiving lots of use but the jack rail fence around the spring below the pond has failed and the spring has received extreme use resulting in the trough not working. Some cattle are up high. Sheldon walked the Salt Riparian fence and found the unfenced portion. Mod-Heavy use on Lower Salt, Light-Mod on upper Salt. Cattle should be moved out of Salt on Monday 7/16 *J. Robson*

8/14/2007, went up Frank Hall and Wild Cat today, heavy use on Frank Hall, cattle are mostly on private now, and cattle will need to move ahead of schedule. Moderate use on wildcat creek, cattle still present. *J Robson*
