

NOTICE OF DECISION

The Uinta National Forest has completed an environmental analysis for a proposal from Utah County Public Works Department to install a T1 fiber optic communications cable that would connect to an existing telephone line near Hanging Rock (about 3 miles from the mouth of American Fork Canyon), and continue eastward to the South Fork Guard Station. At the South Fork Guard Station, the fiber optic cable would be connected to a new radio system to improve two-way communications from within American Fork Canyon to public service agencies located in Utah Valley.

The project area is located in Sections 24, 25 and 26 of Township 4 South, Range 2 East, Salt Lake Meridian, and lies within the American Fork Management Area of the Pleasant Grove Ranger District.

The Responsible Official, Pleasant Grove District Ranger Pamela Gardner, approved a Decision Memo for this project on October 25, 2004.

This legal notice provides notification of the final decision associated with the project. This decision is not subject to appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12 (f).
